Helpful hints: Is there a topic that you are intrigued about now that you've explored this stimulus? Do you have more questions? Is there anything you want to learn more about? Could you look into other modern adaptations of Shakespeare? Could you research into Elizabethan England to learn more about Shakespeare's day?
